DEPART US

DAY 1

Arrive Kigali, RWANDA - one of fastest developing cities. Visit the GENOCIDE MUSEUM & learn about RWANDA'S not too distant groom past and be inspired for its prospects.

DAY 2

Explore the ELLEN DEGENERES CAMPUS of the DIAN FOSSEY GORILLA FUND & enjoy an interactive exhibit focusing on Dian Fossey's story and conservation of mountain gorillas.

DAY 3

GORILLA TREKKING – a long-awaited journey in search of mountain gorillas in the Volcanoes National Park. Once we find the gorilla family, we have a maximum an hour to enjoy in their company.

DAY 4

Your choice of activity from one of the below options:

TRAVERSE AN ANCIENT VOLCANO : Venture up Mt Bisoke, over 12000 feet - a challenging hike, magical views overlooking beautiful crater lake.

HIKE TO HONOUR DIAN FOSSEY: Feel humbled by a trek to Dian Fossey's grave, paying respects to a renowned primatologist who saved a species.

UNCOVER ANCIENT CAVES : Feel the weight of 65 million years as you step back in time in the Musanze caves. Stretching 1,25 miles, these historic caves were once used to store food for the kings of Rwanda. Led by a guide, each cave reveals dramatic rock formations pierced with cascading light shafts, spilling greenery and a colony of bats.

FOLLOW IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF GOLDEN MONKEYS: Encounter the endangered golden monkeys, following them as they go about their daily lives amongst the treetops. Following the trail of bamboo, learn how to trace this rare species.

DAY 5

Last day and flight home.

Note: This itinerary can easily be extended with a safari in any of the East Africa parks and even a beach stay on the island of Zanzibar.
