

## EXCURSIONS AND ENTERTAINMENT IN KNYSNA, PLETTENBERG BAY AND OUDTSHOORN

Scheduled and accompanied by a professional guide

### **ABSEILING (Code: KSD01)**



Jump like a superman and then fly-fall 50m down to the foot of the canyon. The ultimate delight comes from the last 25m, while flying through the tops of the trees ending up at the waterfall. This trip is for the ultimate adrenaline rush at the world's most awe-inspiring site! While you admire the breathtaking 50m-drop off the edge of the cliff and the waves crashing below you, your guide will give you all the necessary instructions and do his final safety checks, so no previous experience needed. In comparison with a Bungi jump, it's not just a free fall, it's a controlled (via slowing down and speeding up maneuvers) flight. All transfers included in the cost. Daily at 13h30 – 16h30. Duration 3 hours, minimum 2 pax/no kids under 12

### **CANOING KNYSNA RIVER (Code: KSD02)**



The canoeing takes place on the Touw River Estuary in the heart of the Wilderness National Park. To get to the end of the river, you canoe on flatwater, through indigenous forest for roughly 45minutes. Birdlife is abundant up river and one often sees the scarlet flash of the Knysna Loerie, or the magnificent blue of the malachite kingfisher. From the end of the river one can walk for roughly 40 minutes on a newly constructed boardwalk to the Touw River Waterfall. The return journey takes the same amount of time. Daily at 08h30 /13h30. Duration is 5 hours, minimum 2 pax.

### **GUIDED HIKING TRAILS - ROBBERG NATURE RESERVE (Code: KSD03)**



Robberg Nature Reserve along with kilometres of glorious beaches, edges the "Bay Beautiful" - Plettenberg Bay. Robberg has it all - spectacular scenery, unimpeded vistas of ocean and shore, uniquely adapted vegetation, a thriving seal colony, caracal, grysbok, porcupine, rock hyrax sunbirds and seabirds and funny little lizards (agamas) who watch you quizzically wherever you sit. Take a guided walk - especially tailored to suit your personal interests and fitness level. Daily at 08h30 / 14h00. Duration 4 hours, minimum 2 pax.

### **CANOPY RIDES (Code: KSD05)**

Enjoy the unequalled beauty of the indigenous forest Tsitsikama, traversing 30m above the forest floor. From the start on the launch platform, a new world unfolds as one gently glides on steel cables. The platforms provide an unbelievable view of this enchanting new world with a magnificent birdlife. Your guides enthusiastically explain the ecology of the forest, pointing out different trees and giant ferns way below.

### **QUADBIKING (Code: KSD06) In Knysna**



Those who crave adrenaline and excitement, are offered energetic bumpy ride on muddy roads, full of rocks and ravines. From the top of the dunes you will enjoy a magnificent view of the Indian Ocean, Knysna lagoon and Outeniqua Mountains. Daily at 10h30 / 15h00, weather permitting. Duration 1 hour, min 2 pax.

Daily from 08h30 till 17h00 Duration 30 min.

### *KLEIN KAROO KALEIDOSCOPE (Code: KSD10)*



Your adventure begins as we depart Wilderness via Dolphin Point to the historic town of Mossel Bay. We stop at the famous “Post Office Tree” and visit the Diaz and Maritime Museums famed for their relics of early explorers. Our tour continues via Robertson Pass, a landscaped path, fashioned almost entirely by water, reflecting all the greenery in its mirror-like surface, to South Africa’s “ostrich capital” – a hospitable town of Oudtshoorn. Here don’t miss an opportunity to sit on an ostrich and those who are brave enough can even try their hand at riding the world’s largest bird. After a traditional lunch (included), we continue to the Cango Caves, where majestic stalagmites and stalactites enigmatically form incredible shapes, leaving you in amazement by the nature’s architectural abilities. (Lunch included). Duration 8 hours, minimum 2 pax

### *RETURN TO EDEN (Code:KSD11)*



Your ecological adventure begins with an exciting cruise departure from Plettenberg Bay and heads east past the bird sanctuary and beautiful beaches to the famous Arch rock. Cruising along the breathtaking shores, the unique geology, dolphins, sharks, whales and seal colonies can be closely observed. On docking, some refreshments, after which we travel up the Indian Ocean seaboard to the “Birds of Eden” sanctuary. This sanctuary has its own mysterious ruin, incorporating a walk behind a waterfall. Its dome has the ability to synthesize thunder and create short spells of rain from an irrigation system in the structure. Our next stop is Monkeyland, where you’ll be privileged to be able to step into the world of primates and learn fascinating facts about these animals, first hand. (Lunch included)  
Daily. Duration 8 hours.

### *CROCODILE CAGE DIVING (Code:KSD12)*



Experience the thrill that is second to none in the world – Croc Cage Diving with 4 meter man-eating monsters! Due to their man-eating habits the crocodiles spend their time sizing the cage diver up as a potential meal, so Croc Cage Diving is definitely not for the faint-hearted.

To prove that you are brave enough to actually complete your dive, you get a snapshot of yourself surrounded by these carnivores.
