### SAFARI TOURS AND EXCURSIONS ON LAND (ZIT01)

#### SAFARI IN VICTORIA FALLS GAME RESERVE (Code: ZIT0101)



This 4000 hectare Victoria Falls Private Game Reserve is situated only 12kms from Victoria Falls town centre in Zimbabwe.

Private Game Reserve just 10 minutes' drive from the world-famous Victoria Falls and Zambezi River.

Accompanied by an experienced guide, you have a unique opportunity to encounter with lions, rhinos, elephants, buffaloes and leopards in their natural habitat. The mysterious world of the wild has never been so close.

**Please note!** Conservation park fees of US\$15 per person is payable in addition to the below rate.

#### NIGHT SAFARI WITH DINNER (Code: ZIT0102)



After a delicious traditional dinner, depart on a night safari in an open land rover, accompanied by a professional game ranger and tracker in search of the "Big Five" perhaps even following the predators on their hunt in the Victoria Falls Private Game Reserve. This experience is guaranteed to be both adventures and suspenseful.

#### SAFARI IN HWANGE NATIONAL PARK (Code: ZIT0103)



Hwange is one of the largest national parks in Zimbabwe, covering an area in excess of 14,600 km<sup>2</sup>, located 2-hours away from the town of Victoria Falls. The park showcases a combination of sandy deserts and forests, amazing beauty of the open valleys with extensive areas of green meadows and pastures with lots of water. The park is home to the largest population of elephants, wild dogs, as well as home to more than 103 species of large mammals and 300 species of birds.

Cost includes a picnic lunch and refreshments.

#### SAFARI IN THE CHOBE NATIONAL PARK IN BOTSWANA (Code: ZIT0104)



Take a unique boat trip to the Botswana through the Chobe River Zambezi. An interesting fact is that the crossing will occur at the border of four countries - Namibia, Botswana, Zambia and Zimbabwe.

After border formalities, you will be transferred onboard a wharf across the Chobe River. Chobe is one of the largest natural reserves (covering 11 thousand km<sup>2</sup> of the country) in Botswana and is positioned only 2 hours away from the famous town of Victoria Falls. Chobe houses the biggest population of elephants in Africa (up to 35000). The slow flowing river acts as a watering hall to many herds of elephants, zebras, various antelopes, lions, hyenas, leopards, wild

dogs and many other animals, as well as a myriad of birds.

After lunch at local lodge, depart on a game drive in an open land rover in search of elephants, giraffe, buffalo (usually graze in huge herds), and all kinds of antelope (including the "Gnu"). With a certain share of luck you will be able to see his Majesty the King of the Wild - The Lion. The price includes lunch and refreshments during the river crossing safari.

**Please note!** Botswana visa may be required and including this tour may result in a slight increase in visa costs on your stay in Zimbabwe

#### ELEPHANT BACK SAFARI (Code: ZIT0105)



It is a truly unforgettable experience to explore the wild on elephant back accompanied by a highly professional guide knowledgeable on the habits and behaviour of elephants.

Safari includes tea, coffee, beer, wine and snacks after the safari. Videos and photos can be purchased for at an additional cost after the tour.

#### INTERACTION WITH ELEPHANTS (Code: ZIT0106)

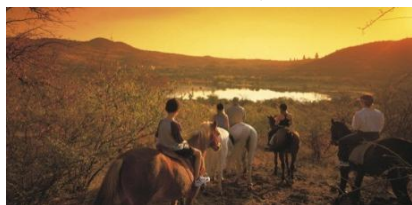

**HORSE BACK SAFARI (Code: ZIT0108)**



It is not necessary to be an experienced rider to ride on horseback along the Zambezi River and the surrounding savannah. Experienced guides will group the participants (according to riding experience). The tour begins at the bewildered road, where you will see the natural beauty of the Zambian nature. During this relaxing and enjoyable trip, you encounter various wild animals and exotic birds.

**WALKING SAFARI (Code: ZIT0109)**



True connoisseurs of the wildlife are thrilled to take a unique walking tour within the savannah of the Zambezi National Park. Accompanied by an experienced ranger and tracker, you will hear the fascinating story of the life and habits of elephants, buffalo, hippos, crocodiles, giraffes, zebras, antelopes and other members of the animal world. Take a chance to familiarize yourself with the African wildlife.

**WALK WITH THE LIONS (Code: ZIT0110)**



Walk side by side with the King of the Jungle. You are invited to take a walk on the wild side and interact with the rowdy adolescents as well as learn about the conservation issues on the walk with lions safari. Come walk with the Pride...no leashes, no collars, and the pride roam freely with you through the African bush in this walk with lions activity.

Walking with Lions - is a stimulating wildlife adventure

You will have the opportunity to walk, interact and observe the cubs in their natural environment.

**CROCODILE ADVENTURES (Code: ZIT0111)**



A memorable visit to a crocodile farm where you encounter thousands of crocodiles, learn about them, their habits and survival skills. Do not refuse an offer to pick up a baby crocodile. Despite the fact that in the wild, they are considered as one of the most dangerous predators, crocodile continues to be vulnerable to human encroachment.

**EXCURSIONS ON WATER (ZIT02)**

**EXCLUSIVE ISLAND LIVINGSTONE (Code: ZIT0201)**



Livingstone Island is merely a 5 minute cutter ride along the Zambezi from the Royal Livingstone sun deck. The island "touches" one of the thresholds of the falls, with water thundering down from a 100m height. Doctor David Livingstone discovered this divine mighty Fall for the very first time precisely from this point and named it in honor of his queen.

The island is accessible only by a small (16-seater) boat. This tour is conducted in the months of July through to January, minimum 2 pax.

**Please note!** The price does not include Zambia visa fees. Yellow fever vaccination certificate is required on visiting Zambia.

Livingstone Island - morning visit (at 07:30, 09:00 u 10:30) including tea, coffee, refreshment drinks and light snacks. Duration 3 hours, minimum 2 pax

Livingstone Island - Lunch time visit (at 12:30) including lunch, refreshment drinks , beer and wine.

**ZAMBEZI RIVER CRUISE (Code:ZIT0203)**



Don't miss this opportunity and take an exciting Zambezi river cruise onboard of a pontoon, on an upper flow of the Victoria Falls. The upper flow of the river has various large and small islands covered with lush tropical vegetation, as well as is home to many predators and birds. The comfortable pontoons used for this cruises(ZAMBEZI EXPLORER, ZAMBEZI REFLECTIONS, KALUNDA, MA ROBERT), can comfortably seat between 14 and 90 people.

**THE VICTORIA (Code:ZIT0203.1)**



Take a river safari downstream towards the smoke that thunders, whilst lounging in comfort. The Victoria bears the mark of exclusivity in cruises for the region; it is jet propelled and specially designed to safely navigate the shallow waters just above the falls. Enjoy a luxurious experience like none other as we take you on a romantic tour of one of the most historical sections on the Zambezi river. Elephants are frequently seen crossing this section on the same route that David Livingstone took when he first discovered and named this exceptional waterfall. A Victoria Falls Hotel chef will be preparing sushi and other gourmet canapés served with selections of beverages. This exclusive boat caters for max of 20 pax.

Afternoon activity, sushi and gourmet canapés, as well as local and imported spirits, mixers, beers, wines, soft drinks.

**WATER RAFTING IN THE ZAMBEZI RIVER (Code: ZIT0203)**



The rapids behind the Victoria Falls are generally violent, however relatively safe due to high water level of the river, sheer walls of the canyon as well as absence of underwater rocks.

Debriefing will be conducted during breakfast time, followed by a walk to the departure point.

The largest rapids, with difficulty level of 4 and 5 (perhaps the highest in the world) are concentrated at the top part of the river, near the Batoka gorge (rapids №1 to №10). Rapids №11 to №23 are characterized by the fast current and are passing large amount of whirlpools.

After completion of a descend, the return climb up a gorge (220m) is quite strenuous as well. At the top, ice cold refreshments await you. One hour drive back to the hotel, where your adventure

filled day will be conclude with an entertaining dinner, watching a video, filmed by your tour guide during your adventure. Copies of the video can also be purchased at an additional cost.

**JET BOAT EXTREME (Code: ZIT0204)**



This is a great way to satisfy your need for adventure with speeds of up to 90 km per hour on the Zambezi River in the Batoka Gorge. Feel the 360 horse power as you rush through the rapids, do 360 degree spins on the flat water while passing big rocks and the Gorge wall only a few inches away from the boat.

**CANOE SAFARI (Code: ZIT0205)**



This a very unique safari experience, on board a 2-seater canoe, along the banks of the Zambezi River. It is in this exact way that Dr. David Livingstone, reached and discovered the Victoria Falls. As your senses are heightened, you clearly hear surrounding birds singing as well as animal roaring. Hippo, elephant, buffalo and many other animals that come to the river bank to quench their thirst will pose for your amusement. Enjoy an especially prepared dinner, during which your guide will uncover the history, traditions, myths, and the amazing flora and fauna of the surrounding area.

**RIVERBOARDING AND RAFTING IN THE ZAMBEZI RIVER (Code: ZIT0206)**



Wild mighty Zambezi River is considered one of the best places in the world for extreme water sports. You begin the extreme descent with a surfer board, passing-by boiling water rapids. Following a short rest, climb on board an inflatable raft in order to avoid injury during the passage of the most dangerous areas. Adrenaline filled water adventures are available all year round, but still entirely dependent on the level of water in the Zambezi river. The price includes tea and coffee.

**FISHING (Code: ZIT0207)**



The Zambezi river offers excellent fishing all year round. Fishing in the upper part of the river is often more than very successful. Tilapia, Catfish and the famous Tiger fish are commonly found in these waters. This trip will be enjoyable to anyone, from a novice to a professional fisherman. Please note that in order to protect the environment, your catch must be released back into the river, however not before you capture your catch on film.

**AIR SAFARI (Code: ZIT0301)**



The grandeur and the incredible beauty of the mighty Victoria Falls can only be truly appreciated from a bird's-eye view, flying along the edge of the Falls, where the rapid flow of water rush down over 100 meter drop. In addition, observe the majestic elephants calmly walking across the green islands, crocodiles and hippos, half submerged in water and an overall total abundance of beauty. Your camera is cannot be forgotten during this excursion. We wish you an incredible flying experience!

**ADRENALINE FILLED TOURS (ZIT04)**

**ADRENALINE FILLED «BUNGI JUMPING, BRIDGE SLIDE and the BRIDGE SWING»**

Those eager to truly experience African energy are welcome to take a dizzying leap from a 111-meter height above the raging river and the mighty Zambezi, swaying in the middle of the gorge, like on a swing. If the thought of jumping off the bridge scares you, then try a slide along the rope, right through the valley, enjoying views of the colourful neighbourhoods and this experience will remain in your memory for a lifetime. Briefing is done on site, prior training is not required.

**Please note!** Price does not include transfer from hotel/lodge to the bridge and back.

**BRIDGE SLIDE SINGLE (CODE: ZIT0401)**



Dramatic views and an incredible feeling await you as you slide along the Batoka gorge, coming to safe landing at the Victoria Falls Bridge.

Minimum 1 pax

**BRIDGE SLIDE TANDEM (CODE: ZIT0402)**



As you get comfortable in your rope chair, breathe in – admiring the absolute beauty surrounding you. You slide right through the gorge in tandem with your friend, partner or a child older than 6 years.

Minimum 2 pax



**BRIDGE SWING SINGLE (CODE: ZIT0403)**



*This one is not for the faint hearted! A fixed jump into the gorge from a height of a 70 meter starting point and then swinging to a complete stop. You may choose to jump "face forward" or take an exciting dive, falling backwards into the gorge.*

**BRIDGE SWING TANDEM (CODE: ZIT0404)**



*Share this adrenaline filled experience with your friend or partner! Jump in tandem and get a double sensation of flying!*

Minimum 2 pax

**BUNGI JUMPING (Code: ZIT0405)**



*Jumping off a bridge, which connects Zimbabwe and Zambia, is only for the brave and courageous! Test your courage by jumping from a 111 meter high Livingstone Bridge over the Zambezi River - one of the highest "Bungi" in the world.*

**LIVINGSTONE BRIDGE TOUR (Code: ZIT0504)**



*This unforgettable excursion along one of the five bridges over the Zambezi River is accompanied by a professional tour guide. Only this bridge, which is more than a century old - was built across the gorge and at an angle of 45 degrees to the Victoria Falls, connects 2 countries: Zambia and Zimbabwe. The bridge is constructed in the form of an arch and is 250 meters long, with height above the river measuring at 125 meters. The bridge offers a magnificent view of the bottom of the gorge from the one side, and the gorgeous view of the Victoria Falls on other side. From the bridge, one can truly appreciate the depth of the gorge, with its vegetation at the bottom, sparkling black rocks and lush green foliage. The panorama view from the bridge takes your breath away!*
