

Day 3

Greater Kruger National Park

SOUTH AFRICA

After Breakfast, transfer to Johannesburg. Connect to flight to Kruger Park (1.5 hrs inflight - economy class)
NOTE: This is a commercial flight. Luggage restrictions 44lbs per person for checked in luggage and +-10lbs per person for carry on

Arrive and transfer to **Buhala Lodge** built on the banks of the Crocodile River which has sweeping views over the Kruger National Park.



BUHALA LODGE

Located on the banks of the Crocodile River and bordering Kruger National Park, Buhala Lodge features elegant rooms, an outdoor pool and open deck spa.

The elegantly decorated rooms and suites all have air conditioning and tea-and-coffee-making facilities. The rooms are located in the main building. Some of them have balconies. The suites are separate and feature a verandah with views of Kruger National Park and the Crocodile River.

Breakfast is provided every morning. Dinner is served in the dining room or outside under the stars.

The Buhala Lodge boasts an open deck spa, where guests can request a massage for a fee or choose from a variety of beauty treatments. The spa overlooks Kruger Park and the river.

On arrival, time to settle in and depart on an afternoon safari game drive in Kruger National Park

Day 4

Greater Kruger National Park

SOUTH AFRICA

We set off for some serious golf on the number one golf course in South Africa, **Leopard Creek Golf Country Club**.

Innovative architectural and landscaping techniques ensure that the Leopard Creek golf course and living areas are naturally protected from animals, while lakes and small streams have been diverted through the development to create scenic vistas and interesting golf strategies.

Golfing hazards take on a new dimension at Leopard Creek, for much of the water is home to the magnificent creatures for which the river is named, crocodiles. Extensive use has been made of water features and sightings of crocodile, hippo, antelope, buffalo and elephant are commonplace, on the course or in the Kruger Park bordering the course.

The 505 meter par-five 13th is one of Leopard Creek's most memorable holes. Here the green is right on the edge of the Crocodile river but 32 meters above the level of the water, offering magnificent views up the river and into the Kruger Park.

Gary Player is especially proud of the par-five 18th with its island green and the par-four 9th with its peninsula green jutting out of the same body of water.
