Day 1	<p>Arrive Cape Town, transfer to the hotel with a Salute Africa representative.</p> <p>Table Bay Hotel 5*/ Radisson Blu Hotel & Residence 4*/ SunSquare Cape Town City Bowl 3* (or similar)</p> <p>Evening at leisure - <i>explore the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront, situated in the oldest working harbor in the southern hemisphere, with the iconic Table Mountain as its backdrop and is one of Africa's most visited malls</i></p>	
Day 2	<p>Following breakfast depart on a half day CAPE TOWN CITY & CABLE CAR TO TABLE MOUNTAIN <i>The tour includes various stops like SA Museum, the Malay Quarter and the Harbour, Greenmarket Square, Sea Point, Clifton and Camps Bay. We visit to the newest 7th wonder of the world – Table Mountain (weather permitting)</i></p>	
Day 3	<p>Following breakfast, a full day guided excursion to CAPE POINT - a world heritage site and a romantic meeting place of the Indian and the Atlantic Oceans – lunch included (meals only)</p> <p><i>We travel through the picturesque Hout Bay, along the breathtaking Chapman's Peak Drive towards a narrow finger of land, covered in endemic fynbos and home to picturesque bays, beaches, rolling green hills and valleys. The day includes a cruise to the seal colony, a delicious seafood lunch and a visit to Boulders beach - COLONY OF ENDANGERED AFRICAN PENGUINS</i></p>	
Day 4	<p>Following breakfast, Full Day guided excursion to the CAPE WINECOUNTRY – lunch included (meals only).</p> <p><i>Visiting the best vineyards covered valleys of South Africa – Paarl, Stellenbosch and Franschhoek. As we learn about this region and how it came about, we visit some of the award-winning wineries. With over 300 in the area to choose from, no two are alike. Today not only do you savour wine tasting but we also explore some fabulous Cape Dutch architecture of which the region is famous for including its array of little boutiques and shops.</i></p>	
Day 5	<p>Early morning transfer to the airport and flight to Zimbabwe (with possible connection). Note: Luggage restricted to 50lbs per person</p> <p>On arrival, transfer to the hotel.</p> <p>Victoria Falls Hotel 5* / Kingdom Hotel (program 4* and 3*)</p> <p>Afternoon walking TOUR OF VICTORIA FALLS</p>	
Day 6	<p>Early morning ELEPHANT BACK SAFARI in Victoria Falls National Park. <i>This is a truly unforgettable experience to explore the wild on elephant back accompanied by a highly professional guide knowledgeable on the habits and behaviour of elephants. Safari on elephant back includes tea, coffee, beer, wine and snacks after the safari.</i></p> <p>Note: No children under 4 y/o are permitted for this excursion</p> <p><i>Rest of the day at personal leisure, alternatively additional activities (at a supplementary cost) such as fishing, a visit to the Livingstone Island, helicopter flights over the falls, walking with lions, walking with cheetah, cultural visits and Boma dinner and many others.</i></p>	
Days 7 - 9	<p>Today you cross over to Botswana. Following some boarder formalities, arrive in CHOBE NATIONAL PARK</p> <p>Chobe Safari Lodge (irrespective of chosen star rating, or similar)</p> <p>The next 3 days are action packed, with 4 SAFARI activities (land and water based) as well as a CULTURAL TOUR in a local village of the neighboring Namibia in a 4x4 vehicle or in a motorised boat, ensuring maximum visibility of the Park's spectacular scenery and abundant wildlife. Chobe has a great diversity and concentration of wildlife and is home to the largest concentration of Elephant in Africa.</p> <p>Dinner at the lodge</p>	
Day 10	<p>After breakfast, transfer to Victoria Falls airport with some boarder formalities en-route.</p> <p>Flight to Johannesburg Note: Luggage restricted to 50lbs per person</p> <p>On arrival, connect to your flight home</p>
