



CAPETOWN (4n) – VICTORIA FALLS (2n) – CHOBE NATIONAL PARK (2n) – DUNES OF SOSSUSVLEI (2n) - 11 days/10 nights

Day 1	<p>Arrive Cape Town, transfer to the hotel with a Salute Africa representative.</p> <p>Table Bay Hotel 5*/ Radisson Blu Hotel & Residence 4*/ SunSquare Cape Town City Bowl 3* (or similar)</p> <p>Evening at leisure - <i>explore the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront, situated in the oldest working harbor in the southern hemisphere, with the iconic Table Mountain as its backdrop and is one of Africa's most visited malls</i></p>	
Day 2	<p>Following breakfast depart on a half day CAPE TOWN CITY & CABLE CAR TO TABLE MOUNTAIN <i>The tour includes various stops like SA Museum, the Malay Quarter and the Harbour, Greenmarket Square, Sea Point, Clifton and Camps Bay. We visit to the newest 7th wonder of the world – Table Mountain (weather permitting)</i></p>	
Day 3	<p>Following breakfast, a full day guided excursion to CAPE POINT - a world heritage site and a romantic meeting place of the Indian and the Atlantic Oceans. <i>We travel through the picturesque Hout Bay, along the breathtaking Chapman's Peak Drive towards a narrow finger of land, covered in endemic fynbos and home to picturesque bays, beaches, rolling green hills and valleys. The day includes a cruise to the seal colony, a delicious seafood lunch and a visit to Boulders beach - COLONY OF ENDANGERED AFRICAN PENGUINS</i></p>	
Day 4	<p>Day at leisure, or <i>additional excursions at a supplementary cost</i></p> <p><i>Soak up some African Sun at one of its finest beaches, or explore the Cape Wine country, visit some of the art galleries, taste some street cuisine at organic city markets and much more. For the more adventurous visitor, this city is your oyster – from hiking to abseiling to white shark cage diving</i></p>	
Days 5 - 6	<p>Early morning transfer to the airport and flight to Zimbabwe (with possible connection). <i>Note: Luggage is restricted to 50lbs per person</i></p> <p>On arrival, transfer to the hotel.</p> <p>Victoria Falls Hotel 5* / Kingdom Hotel (program 4* and 3*)</p> <p>Included activity: a walking TOUR OF VICTORIA FALLS</p> <p><i>Various additional activities available (at a supplementary cost) such as Livingstone Island – Devils pool, helicopter flights over the falls, walking with lions, walking cultural visits and Boma dinner, dinner onboard a retro style steam locomotive and many others.</i></p>	
Days 7 - 8	<p>Today we cross over to Botswana, following boarder formalities, arrive in CHOBE NATIONAL PARK</p> <p>Chobe Game Lodge 5* / Chobe Safari Lodge 4* (or similar)</p> <p>The next 2 days are actioned packed, with 4 SAFARI (land & water) <i>...in a 4x4 vehicle or in a motorised boat, ensuring maximum visibility of the spectacular scenery and abundant wildlife. Chobe offers great diversity & concentration of wildlife and is known for the largest concentration of Elephant in Africa. Lunch and Dinner at the lodge</i></p>	
Days 9 - 10	<p>Following an early morning SAFARI,</p> <p>Breakfast at the lodge and transfer to the airport in Namibia with boarder formalities en-route (+2 hours drive)</p> <p>Flight to Windhoek (+1 hr flight). <i>Note: Luggage restricted to 44lbs pp</i></p> <p>On arrival, transfer to Sossusvlei (+3,5 hours drive)</p> <p>Desert Grace Lodge 5*/ Taleni Sossusvlei Lodge 4* (or similar)</p> <p><i>The following activities are included in the course of you stay:</i></p> <p>The NAMIB NAUKLUFT DESERT visit, the famous DEADVLEI with its dead Kamelthorn trees and the most photographed dune, Dune 45 and a visit to the SESRIEM CANYON</p> <p><i>Stretching 1,200 miles in length, but averaging a width of only 70 miles, the Namib Desert is home to the highest sand dunes in the world.</i></p> <p>Breakfast, lunch and dinner at the lodge</p>	
Day 11	<p>Breakfast at the lodge and transfer to Windhoek Airport (+3,5 hours)</p> <p>Flight to Johannesburg <i>Note: Luggage restricted to 50lbs per person</i></p> <p>On arrival, connect to your flight home</p>
