













Tanzania in East Africa, home to the highest mountain on the continent – snow-peaked Mount Kilimanjaro, offers an abundance of landscapes to explore and wildlife to encounter. From a carpet of pink flamingo's in Lake Manyara to big tuskers in the Crater of Ngorongoro and the Great Migration in the Serengeti, Tanzania is a safari dream come true.

This safari can be and is recommended to be extended with Gorilla trekking or an island paradise with white soft-sandy beaches and shimmering azure waters of Zanzibar

<p>Day 1 Tarangire TANZANIA</p>	<p>Arrive Kilimanjaro (arrival no later than 11:00 am) A warm welcome by Salute Africa representative and begin your safari adventure, setting out to Tarangire National Park. (±3,5 hours by road)</p> <p>With some of the greatest concentration of wildlife, this Park offers a haven for predators. It is also the one place in Tanzania where dry-country antelope such as the stately fringe-eared Oryx and peculiar long-necked gerenuk are regularly observed. The tinged green swamps are the focus for 550 bird species.. Named after the Tarangire River which flows through it, the park is known for large herds of elephants and majestic baobab trees and twisted acacia.</p> <p>SAFARI in the Tarangire National Park with a picnic lunch. Later afternoon, transfer to the lodge</p> <p>Dinner at the lodge</p>	 
<p>Day 2 Ngorongoro Crater TANZANIA</p>	<p>After breakfast transfer to and descend into the Ngorongoro Crater for an unforgettable SAFARI (picnic lunch included) The Crater is about 12 miles wide and its rim rises 1,200-1,600 feet off of its expansive 102-square-mile floor. Once a gigantic volcano, some maintain that before it erupted, it would have been higher than Mt Kilimanjaro, the highest peak in Africa. Today it is the largest intact caldera in the world, with an extensive highland area, and the Ngorongoro Crater is a focal point. Endangered black rhino are protected within its rim, giant tusked elephants wander the forests, black-maned lions stalk the grasslands, and flamingos crowd the soda lakes. An estimated 25 000 large mammals are resident in this bowl of plenty, including a population of approximately 6 000 resident wildebeest, 16 highly endangered black rhino and around 70 lions.</p> <p>Arrive and check in at the lodge Dinner served in the designed area for the evening</p>	 
<p>Day 3 Serengeti TANZANIA</p>	<p>Following breakfast, we depart to Serengeti National Park (±4 – 4,5 hours by road) Arrive at the lodge in time for lunch. Early afternoon, an exciting game viewing SAFARI in one of the BEST game parks in Tanzania. Covering an area of 14,763 square kilometres, the world famous Serengeti National Park is Tanzania's oldest park, and one of the world's last great wildlife refuges. It stretches as far as Lake Victoria to the West. Its name comes from the Maasai word Siringet, meaning 'endless plains'. The Serengeti ecosystem supports the greatest remaining concentration of plains game in Africa, including more than three million large mammals.</p> <p>Return to the lodge. Dinner at the lodge.</p>	 

<p>Day 4</p> <p>Serengeti TANZANIA</p>	<p>Breakfast and a full day SAFARI in the Serengeti National Park (picnic bush hamper lunch included) Return to the lodge late afternoon and time at leisure. If in luck, observe animals gathering at the nearest waterhole</p> <p>Dinner at the lodge <i>Evenings are spent gathered by the traditional fire pit and exchanging stories under starry skies and listening to tales of wildlife encounters and historical derring-do from the passionate guides</i></p>	
<p>Day 5</p> <p>Olduvai Gorge TANZANIA</p>	<p>Following breakfast, we return towards the Ngorongoro Conservation area with a visit to the famous Olduvai Gorge en-route (±4 hours by road) Picnic lunch en-route <i>Olduvai Gorge, is internationally recognized for Louis and Mary Leakey's famous discoveries of early humans and magnificent antiquities documenting the evolutionary history of our stone tool-using ancestors, vertebrate fauna, and the environments over the last two million years.</i></p> <p>On arrival at the lodge, check in and dinner</p>	
<p>Day 6</p> <p>Lake Manyara TANZANIA</p> <p><i>Departure or extension</i></p>	<p>Breakfast and set out to Lake Manyara National Park for unforgettable safari experience (picnic bush hamper lunch included)</p> <p><i>Lake Manyara National Park offers a wilderness experience in diverse habitats, from its Rift Valley soda lake to dense woodlands and steep mountainsides. Apart from a spectacular setting, the park is famous for its unusual tree-climbing lions and the vast elephant herds it was established to protect. The shores of the lake, encrusted with pink flamingo, attract more than 400 species of birds, many of them waterfowl or migrants. Large herds of buffalo, cheetah, Masai giraffe and impala roam the lake shores and the forested valley slopes. A Lake Manyara safari is a fascinating experience, as the park also features a ground-water forest, acacia tortilis woodland and hot springs called Maji Moto. Troops of several hundred olive baboon appear alongside Sykes monkey and short-eared galago. Cape clawless otter, Egyptian mongoose, hippo and klipspringer are other park residents.</i></p> <p>Following safari, transfer to Kilimanjaro International airport (±3,5 hours by road) and departure home</p> <p><i>This safari can be and is recommended to be extended with Gorilla trekking or an island paradise with white soft-sandy beaches and shimmering azure waters of Zanzibar</i></p>
