Day 1	<p>Arrive Cape Town, transfer to the hotel with a Salute Africa representative. Table Bay Hotel 5*/ Radisson Blu Hotel & Residence 4*/ SunSquare Cape Town City Bowl 3* (or similar) Evening at leisure - <i>explore the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront, situated in the oldest working harbor in the southern hemisphere, with the iconic Table Mountain as its backdrop and is one of Africa's most visited malls</i></p>	
Day 2	<p>Following breakfast depart on a half day CAPE TOWN CITY & CABLE CAR TO TABLE MOUNTAIN <i>The tour includes various stops like SA Museum, the Malay Quarter and the Harbour, Greenmarket Square, Sea Point, Clifton and Camps Bay. We visit to the newest 7th wonder of the world – Table Mountain (weather permitting)</i></p>	
Day 3	<p>Following breakfast, a full day guided excursion to CAPE POINT - a world heritage site and a romantic meeting place of the Indian and the Atlantic Oceans. <i>We travel through the picturesque Hout Bay, along the breathtaking Chapman's Peak Drive towards a narrow finger of land, covered in endemic fynbos and home to picturesque bays, beaches, rolling green hills and valleys. The day includes a cruise to the seal colony, a delicious seafood lunch and a visit to Boulders beach - COLONY OF ENDANGERED AFRICAN PENGUINS</i></p>	
Day 4	<p>Day at leisure in the Mother City, <i>or additional excursions at a supplementary cost</i> <i>Soak up some African Sun at one of its finest beaches, or explore the Cape Wine country, visit some of the art galleries, taste some street cuisine at organic city markets and much more. For the more adventurous visitor, this city is your oyster – from hiking to abseiling to white shark cage diving</i></p>	
Day 5	<p>Early morning transfer to the airport and flight to Livingstone, Zambia. Note: Luggage is restricted to 50lbs per person On arrival, transfer to the hotel. Royal Livingstone Hotel 5 * / Victoria Falls Resort (4* and 3*) Late afternoon SUNSET CRUISE on the Zambezi River</p>	
Day 6	<p>Following breakfast enjoy a walking TOUR OF VICTORIA FALLS <i>Rest of the day at personal leisure, alternatively additional activities (at a supplementary cost) such as Livingstone Island – Devils pool, helicopter flights over the falls, walking with lions, walking with cheetah, cultural visits and Boma dinner, dinner onboard a retro style steam locomotive and many others.</i></p>	
Day 7	<p>Afternoon transfer to Livingstone airport, flight to Nairobi, Kenya. Note: Luggage is restricted to 50lbs per person On arrival, Salute Africa representative will meet you and transfer to The House of Waine Hotel 5 * / Radisson Blu Nairobi (4 * & 3 *)</p>	
Days 8-10	<p>Breakfast at the hotel and depart to Masai Mara. Kichwa Tembo Camp 5 * / Savora Mara (4* & 3*). <i>The Masai Mara National Reserve is home to a vast number of resident wildlife, as well as home to the annual Great Migration. The migratory wildebeest, zebra, kongoni and topi join abundant elephant, hippo, buffalo, giraffe, lion and cheetah. Leopard and serval are frequently encountered, while endangered black rhino can be found in the dense bush thickets. The Mara River is also famed for its enormous crocodiles, which lay in wait for the wildebeest and zebra during the migration, when more than two million wildebeest and zebra move in search of prime grazing land.</i> The next 3 days activities include morning and afternoon game drive SAFARI and 1 afternoon visit a MASAI VILLAGE tour where you learn of this tribe, its culture and their way of life. Dinner at the lodge</p>	
Day 11	<p>Your very last morning GAME DRIVE SAFARI Breakfast and transfer to Nairobi and flight home</p>
