Day 1	<p>Arrive Cape Town, our Salute Africa representative will warmly welcome you to South Africa – a Rainbow nation Transfer to the hotel Table Bay Hotel 5*/ Radisson Blu Hotel & Residence 4*/ SunSquare Cape Town City Bowl 3* (or similar) Evening at leisure - <i>explore Victoria & Alfred Waterfront, situated in the oldest working harbor in the southern hemisphere, with the iconic Table Mountain as its backdrop, it is one of Africa's most visited malls</i></p>	
Day 2	<p>Following breakfast depart on a half day CAPE TOWN CITY & CABLE CAR TO TABLE MOUNTAIN <i>The tour includes various stops like SA Museum, the Malay Quarter and the Harbour, Greenmarket Square, Sea Point, Clifton and Camps Bay.
